The program is hosted by the Gender and Policy (GAP) Center at George Mason University's (GMU's) Schar School of Policy and Government in Arlington, Virginia. University faculty support the program, drawing on their extensive experience and expansive network of policymakers and public-sector professionals.

The program includes an "action project" in which faculty-in-residence help students research a public-facing issue, imitate a legislative hearing, and defend their team's position. This hands-on project helps participants develop public speaking and communication proficiencies, among other enduring skills.
